Sequence of the wedding ceremony:

16.30 : The Master ceremony arrives at the venue.

16.40 : Guests are lead in procession from their room and wedding coordinator to escort the couple to the wedding ceremony location. (may be separate arrivals if required).

17.00 : The Bridal couple arrives at the venue where they are greeted by the resort management, friends and well wishes.

: The couple is decorated with garlands and the Groom presents a bouquet to the Bride.

: Wedding coordinator briefs the couple on the ceremony that is about to commence.

: Start wedding ceremony.

17.50 : Blessing and exchange of rings.

: Nuptial blessing.

18.30 : Open champagne, cut the cake and it is picture time.

(pictures also taken throughout the ceremony).

Choice of venues: (all weddings)

- Resort Beachfront.
- The Swimming Pool.

Optional items: (all items Inclusive tax and service)

- Photography; addition 1,500 per hour
- Professional DVD 20,000 baht for 4 hrs.
- Make-up and hairdressing Baht 5,500 per person
- Suit or dress hire (Thai or formal) Baht 5,500 per person
- Additional corsage or garlands for guests Baht 200 per person

Food and beverage packages:

- 1 hour cocktail reception (open bar house brands) Baht 750 net / person.
- Canapés Baht 440 net / person.
- Heavy cocktail food Baht 500 net / person.
- Wedding dinners; Baht 1,050 net / person (set menu / buffet, a minimum of 40 persons is required for buffet set up)
- Thai classical dance show during dinner Baht 11,000 net (5 sets).

* Minimum 12 persons.*

When you select an outdoor venue for your wedding location, the resort will provide a back-up in-door location in the event of bad weather. There is no extra charge to you for this back-up venue, however by booking an outdoor venue you agree to this back up option with no recourse to the property. Weather is beyond the control of the resort. To help limit this situation, it is strongly recommended that you remain flexible with your actual Wedding day during your stay. On arrival the wedding co-ordinator will discuss with you the weather forecast and agree an appropriate date if needed.

Whilst every effort is made to coordinate your wedding plans before arrival and thus allow you, the time to enjoy your stay, we do appreciate that sometimes, once on-site, you may want to make changes. To facilitate this, our wedding coordinator will meet with you early in your stay to review the arrangements. At this time and subject to availability, you may change your venue and add any optional item to your wedding. It is with regret that pre-booked items cannot be cancelled and services within the wedding packages are non-refundable.

In the event you cancel your plans completely, the deposit is non-refundable outside 30 days. Inside 30 days, 50% of the total cost will be lost.

After completing your quotation form and receiving an appropriate response, securing your wedding is subject to a non-refundable deposit of 10,000 Baht. The balance of your wedding or blessing event is due 30 days prior to arrival. A pro-forma invoice will be issued in good time to arrange payment by bank transfer or credit card.

Getting Married in Thailand

Information you need to know

You will need the following documents

- A certification document from your home consulate, which confirms
 - Both applicants are in full compliance with the requirements of Thai law for Legal marriage (see below)
 - Applicants occupation and annual income.
 - Marital status (both current and previous) of both applicants.
 - Any and all alimony payments and outstanding private debts must be fully disclosed.
 - The names and addresses of two contact persons, resident in the same area as the applicants.

This document must be translated into Thai and subsequently be certified as being accurate by the Thai Foreign Ministry.

- Your passports (originals)
- Divorce documents if previously married.

Conditions of eligibility for marriage according to the Thai Civil Law Statute 2529 Buddhist Calendar (1986 Ad)

- Applicants must be aged 17 years of age on date of marriage registration. Written parental consent is required if aged below 20 years.
- Applicants must not have been judicially adjudged mentally incapacitated so as to negate consent of marriage.
- Applicants must not be close or direct relatives, including sharing a parent. Albeit, through marriage.
- Applicants must not have the same adoptive parents.
- Applicants must not be currently married.
